
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2014-2015.

5 1. To be expended by the department of land and natural
6 resources:

7 A. Waiakaea (Lihi) canal boat ramp and parking lot
8 improvements and Waiakaea canal drainage project,
9 Kauai
10 Plans, design, construction, and equipment for
11 reconstruction and renovation of trailer and vehicle
12 parking lot, boat wash down area, and pavilion to
13 mitigate pedestrian, vehicle, and boat traffic
14 congestion; to dredge canal to reduce erosion of canal
15 banks and improve drainage for safe launching of
16 boats; and to remove old navigational aids and



1 implement new navigational aids that incorporate new
2 maritime technology.

8 B. Land acquisition purchase of allotments I and II

14 A. Kapaa high school, Kauai

15 Plans, design, construction, and equipment for
16 improvements and renovations to Career Pathway
17 classrooms and adjoining facilities including
18 automotive, building and construction, graphic
19 communication, digital media, health service, and
20 culinary arts facilities to provide a learning
21 environment that aligns with current industry
22 standards and practices.




