
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII LABOR RELATIONS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 89-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3 "(b) The board shall be composed of three members of which
4 (1) one member shall be representative of management, (2) one
5 member shall be representative of labor, and (3) the third
6 member, the chairperson, shall be representative of the public.
7 All members shall be appointed by the governor for terms of six
8 years each. Public employers and employee organizations
9 representing public employees may submit to the governor for
10 consideration names of persons to serve as [~~members of the~~
11 ~~board~~] the member representing management or the member
12 representing the public and the governor shall first consider
13 these persons in selecting [~~the~~] these members of the board.
14 The representative of labor shall be selected by the governor
15 from a list of three nominees submitted by the exclusive
16 representative organizations."

17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
2 and apply to appointments to the Hawaii labor relations board
3 occurring after the effective date of this Act.
