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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
4 and to read as follows:

5 "§356D- Resident managers. The authority shall  
6 designate an onsite resident manager at each public housing  
7 complex and state low-income public housing project. The  
8 authority shall determine the criteria for selecting resident  
9 managers at each public housing complex and state low-income  
10 public housing project. Resident managers designated pursuant  
11 to this section shall not be considered employees of the State."

12 PART II

13 SECTION 2. There are established four full-time equivalent  
14 (4.00 FTE) permanent certified public accountant positions in  
15 the Hawaii public housing authority, which shall be appointed by  
16 the executive director of the Hawaii public housing authority  
17 without regard to chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to assist



1 the authority in documenting the financial information of the  
2 authority.

3 PART III

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Public Housing; Resident Managers

**Description:**

Requires the Hawaii public housing authority to designate a resident manager at each federal public housing complex and state low-income public housing project. Establishes four certified public accountant positions to assist with documentation of financial information. Effective July 1, 2050.
