A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL FINES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 210D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§210D- Community environmental rehabilitation special
5	fund. (a) There is established in the state treasury a
6	community rehabilitation special fund.
7	(b) The following moneys shall be deposited in the
8	community environmental rehabilitation special fund:
9	(1) Ten per cent of all moneys received by the State as
10	payment for fines or penalties for environmental
11	violations assessed by the State;
12	(2) Any appropriation by the legislature into the
13	community environmental rehabilitation special fund;
14	(3) Any gift, grant, or donation made to the community
15	environmental rehabilitation special fund; and
16	(4) Any interest earned on sums deposited in the community
17	environmental rehabilitation special fund.

1	(c) The department shall expend moneys contained in the
2	community environmental rehabilitation special fund to restore,
3	improve, or rehabilitate communities affected by the
4	environmental violations from which the funds were generated.
5	§210D- Administration of the community environmental
6	rehabilitation special fund. The department may adopt rules and
7	procedures pursuant to chapter 91 to administer the community
8	environmental rehabilitation special fund."
9	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
