
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAZARDS TO PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
4 the purposes of:
- 5 (1) Cutting, trimming, or removing dangerous trees or
6 branches that pose a hazard to other properties, as
7 provided under section 128-10.3(a)(1), Hawaii Revised
8 Statutes;
- 9 (2) Stabilizing or removing unstable rock and soil
10 hazards, as provided under section 128-10.3(a)(2),
11 Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
- 12 (3) Cleaning streams and waterways to mitigate or prevent
13 flooding or other disasters, as provided under section
14 128-10.3(a)(3), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the civil defense
16 division of the department of defense for the purposes of this
17 Act.



1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
