7	(b)	The director of transportation shall submit a written	
8	report of	findings and recommendations, including any necessary	
9	proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than thirty		
0	days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2015.		
1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much		
13	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a		
14	feasibility study on the construction of an alternative access		
15	road to be built mauka of Farrington highway beginning at		
l6	Lualualei	Naval Magazine road that provides access into and out	
l 7	of the leeward coast of Oahu.
