## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 6 than: 7 \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; (1)\$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] 8 (2) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; 9 (3) 10 (4)\$8.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 11 (5) \$8.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; and 12 \$9.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2017. (6) [The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to be 13 increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 14 15 than 25 cents below the applicable minimum wage by the employee's employer and the combined-amount the employee 16 17 receives from the employee's employer and in tips is at least 50 cents more than the applicable minimum wage.] 18 HB LRB 14-0276.doc



On September 30, 2017, and on September 30 of each 1 2 year thereafter, the department of labor and industrial 3 relations shall calculate an adjusted minimum wage rate. adjusted minimum wage rate shall be calculated to the nearest 4 5 cent using the Honolulu region consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers, CPI-W, or a successor index, 6 7 for the twelve months prior to September 1 of each year as 8 calculated by the United States Department of Labor. Each 9 adjusted minimum wage rate calculated under this subsection 10 shall take effect on the following January 1." 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 13
