
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE NAMING COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§6E- Naming commission; state buildings, parks, and
5 facilities; establishment; appointment; composition; duties.

6 (a) There is established within the department an advisory
7 commission to propose names for state buildings, parks, and
8 facilities. The commission shall consist of nine members to be
9 appointed by the governor in the manner provided by section 26-
10 34; provided that:

11 (1) Three members shall be appointed from a list of not
12 less than nine nominees submitted by the speaker of
13 the house of representatives;

14 (2) Three members shall be appointed from a list of not
15 less than nine nominees submitted by the president of
16 the senate;



1 (3) One member shall be appointed from the state historic
2 preservation division who shall serve as an ex
3 officio, voting member;

4 (4) One member shall be appointed from the state
5 foundation on culture and the arts who shall serve as
6 an ex officio, voting member; and

7 (5) One member shall be appointed to represent the public.

8 (b) The terms of all appointments shall be four years.

9 The governor shall appoint the chairperson of the commission
10 from among the members.

11 (c) The members of the commission shall serve without
12 compensation, but shall be entitled to reimbursement for travel
13 and other necessary expenses while attending meetings and while
14 in discharge of their duties.

15 (d) The department shall provide staff as necessary,
16 including clerical support staff, to assist the commission in
17 its duties.

18 (e) The commission shall be responsible for proposing
19 names or a change of name for any state building, park, or other
20 state facility.

21 (f) The commission shall submit any proposals to the
22 governor for the governor's consideration.

1 (g) The commission shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
2 91 necessary for the purposes of this section."

3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
