
A BILL FOR AN ACT

13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at

14 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is

15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are

16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital

18 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by

19 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
