## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-1202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§103D-1202 Rules. The policy board shall adopt rules in  
4 accordance with chapter 91 governing:

5 (1) The management of properties during their entire life  
6 cycle;

7 (2) The classes of property, whether expendable or  
8 nonexpendable;

9 (3) The action to be taken [~~in case~~] when issues of lost,  
10 stolen, damaged, unserviceable, or unsuitable  
11 property[+] arise, including:

12 (A) A maximum time limit which all issues shall be  
13 reported between a governmental body and  
14 contractor;

15 (B) A duty for a governmental body and a contractor  
16 to cooperate in the investigation of raised  
17 issues; and



1            (C) Penalties for the failure of a governmental body  
 2            or contractor to comply with subparagraphs (A)  
 3            and (B);

4            (4) The sale, lease, trade-in, or disposal of surplus  
 5            property by public auction, competitive sealed  
 6            bidding, or other appropriate method designated by  
 7            rules; provided that no employee of the owning or  
 8            disposing agency shall be entitled to purchase this  
 9            property; and

10           (5) The transfer of excess property."

11           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
