
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-1202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§103D-1202 Rules.** The policy board shall adopt rules in
4 accordance with chapter 91 governing:

5 (1) The management of properties during their entire life
6 cycle;

7 (2) The classes of property, whether expendable or
8 nonexpendable;

9 (3) The action to be taken [~~in case~~] when issues of lost,
10 stolen, damaged, unserviceable, or unsuitable
11 property[+] arise, including:

12 (A) A maximum time limit which all issues shall be
13 reported between a governmental body and
14 contractor; and

15 (B) A duty for a governmental body and a contractor
16 to cooperate in the investigation of raised
17 issues;



1 (4) The sale, lease, trade-in, or disposal of surplus
2 property by public auction, competitive sealed
3 bidding, or other appropriate method designated by
4 rules; provided that no employee of the owning or
5 disposing agency shall be entitled to purchase this
6 property; and

7 (5) The transfer of excess property."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.



Report Title:

Government Accountability; Procurement Policy Board; Government Contracts

Description:

Expands the Procurement Policy Board's mandate to adopt rules regarding lost, stolen, damaged, unserviceable, or unsuitable property to include time limits for issue reporting and a duty for government agencies and contractors to cooperate in the investigation of raised issues. Effective July 1, 2112.
