
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$115,995,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh
6 representative district, as follows.

9 West Hawaii veteran's cemetery

10 Construction of a non-potable

 20 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
2 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
