

#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$58,940,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
5	for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6	sixth representative district, as follows:

8	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective		
9	capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be		
10	expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of		
11	this Act.		
12	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2	2014.
