### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC MEETINGS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 92-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d) No board shall change the agenda, once filed, by
4	adding items thereto without a two-thirds recorded vote of all
5	members to which the board is entitled; provided that no item
6	shall be added to the agenda if it is of reasonably major
7	importance and action thereon by the board will affect a
8	significant number of persons. Items of reasonably major
9	importance not decided at a scheduled meeting shall be
10	considered only [at a] if the meeting [continued] is recessed
11	and reconvened to a reasonable day and time[-] within five days
12	from the scheduled meeting; provided that:
13	(1) Before the recess is called the presiding officer
14	announces the date, time, and location of the
15	reconvened meeting;
16	(2) At all locations where the notice of the scheduled
17	meeting was posted, including the board's website, if
18	applicable, the notice shall be marked, within a

1	reasonable time, to indicate the date, time, and
2	location of the reconvened meeting; and
3	(3) If the scheduled meeting's testimony period was not
4	closed prior to the recess, the scheduled meeting's
5	testimony period shall remain open at the reconvened
6	meeting, until the testimony period is appropriately
7	closed."
8	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
