
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FUEL CELL ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 168, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is
2 amended by amending section (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) For the purposes of this Act:

4 "Electric vehicle" means:

5 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle; [∅]

6 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
7 propulsion energy from a battery with at least four
8 kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
9 recharged from an external source of electricity[-];

10 or

11 (3) A fuel cell electric vehicle.

12 "Fuel cell electric vehicle" means a zero-emission electric
13 vehicle that uses a fuel cell to convert hydrogen gas and oxygen
14 into electricity to charge onboard batteries and power an
15 onboard electric motor to propel the vehicle."

16 SECTION 2. Section 103D-412, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:



1 "(b) Beginning January 1, 2010, all state and county
2 entities, when purchasing new vehicles, shall seek vehicles with
3 reduced dependence on petroleum-based fuels that meet the needs
4 of the agency. Priority for selecting vehicles shall be as
5 follows:

6 (1) Electric or plug-in hybrid electric vehicles~~[+]~~, and
7 ~~[(2) Hydrogen or]~~ fuel cell electric vehicles;
8 ~~[(3)]~~ (2) Other alternative fuel vehicles;
9 ~~[(4)]~~ (3) Hybrid electric vehicles; and
10 ~~[(5)]~~ (4) Vehicles that are identified by the United States
11 Environmental Protection Agency in its annual "Fuel
12 Economy Leaders" report as being among the top
13 performers for fuel economy in their class.

14 (c) For the purposes of this section:

15 "Agency" means a state agency, office, or department.

16 "Alternative fuel" means alcohol fuels, mixtures containing
17 eighty-five per cent or more by volume of alcohols with gasoline
18 or other fuels, natural gas, liquefied petroleum gas, hydrogen,
19 biodiesel, mixtures containing twenty per cent or more by volume
20 of biodiesel with diesel or other fuels, other fuels derived
21 from biological materials, and electricity provided by off-board
22 energy sources.



1 "Covered fleet" has the same meaning as contained in 10
2 Code of Federal Regulations Part 490 Subpart C.

3 "Excluded vehicles" has the same meaning as provided in 10
4 Code of Federal Regulations section 490.3.

5 "Fuel cell electric vehicle" means a zero-emission electric
6 vehicle that uses a fuel cell to convert hydrogen gas and oxygen
7 into electricity to charge onboard batteries and power an
8 onboard electric motor to propel the vehicle.

9 "Light-duty motor vehicle" has the same meaning as
10 contained in 10 Code of Federal Regulations Part 490, not
11 including any vehicle incapable of traveling on highways or any
12 vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating greater than eight
13 thousand five hundred pounds."

14 SECTION 3. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

16 "(b) For the purposes of this section:

17 "Electric vehicle" means:

18 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section
19 286-2; [e#]

20 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
21 propulsion energy from a battery with at least four
22 kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be



1 recharged from an external source of electricity[-];

2 or

3 (3) A fuel cell electric vehicle.

4 "Electric vehicle charging system" means a system that:

5 (1) Is capable of providing electricity from a non-vehicle
6 source to charge the batteries of one or more electric
7 vehicles;

8 (2) Meets recognized standards, including standard SAE
9 J1772 of SAE International; and

10 (3) Is designed and installed in compliance with article
11 625 of the National Electrical Code[-];

12 provided that the term shall not include a facility or system
13 for refueling the hydrogen storage tank of a fuel cell electric
14 vehicle.

15 "Fuel cell electric vehicle" means a zero-emission electric
16 vehicle that uses a fuel cell to convert hydrogen gas and oxygen
17 into electricity to charge onboard batteries and power an
18 onboard electric motor to propel the vehicle.

19 "Place of public accommodation" has the same meaning as
20 that provided in section 489-2."

21 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
