

- 1 (1) Move freely in public spaces, including on public
2 sidewalks, in public parks, on public transportation,
3 and in public buildings without harassment or
4 intimidation from law enforcement officials, in the
5 same manner as other persons;
- 6 (2) Have equal opportunities for employment;
- 7 (3) Receive emergency medical care;
- 8 (4) Register to vote and to vote;
- 9 (5) Have personal information protected;
- 10 (6) Have a reasonable expectation of privacy in one's
11 personal property;
- 12 (7) Receive equal treatment by state and county agencies;
- 13 (8) Apply for programs and services with the federal,
14 state, and county governments and be treated fairly
15 without any discrimination based upon being homeless;
- 16 (9) Choose to accept assistance from any federal, state,
17 or county government when approached to enroll in a
18 program that may improve one's quality of life; and
- 19 (10) Enjoy the same rights and freedoms that every citizen
20 of the United States enjoys under the United States
21 Constitution and the Hawaii State Constitution.



1 (c) Each county may post, in a usual location for county
 2 notices, a notice entitled "A HOMELESS PERSON'S BILL OF RIGHTS"
 3 that contains the text set forth in subsection (b)."

4 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
