
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§8-1 **Holidays designated.** The following days of each
4 year are set apart and established as state holidays:

5 The first day in January, New Year's Day;

6 The third Monday in January, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.,
7 Day;

8 The third Monday in February, Presidents' Day;

9 The twenty-sixth day in March, Prince Jonah Kuhio
10 Kalanianaʻole Day;

11 The Friday preceding Easter Sunday, Good Friday;

12 The last Monday in May, Memorial Day;

13 The eleventh day in June, King Kamehameha I Day;

14 The fourth day in July, Independence Day;

15 The third Friday in August, Statehood Day;

16 The first Monday in September, Labor Day;

17 The eleventh day in November, Veterans' Day;

18 The fourth Thursday in November, Thanksgiving Day;



1 The twenty-fifth day in December, Christmas Day;
2 All election days, except primary and special election
3 days, in the county wherein the election is held; provided that
4 if the office of elections establishes an election by mail
5 process for all registered voters of the State, election days
6 shall no longer be considered a state holiday under this
7 section;

8 Any day designated by proclamation by the President of the
9 United States or by the governor as a holiday."

10 SECTION 2. A collective bargaining agreement that is
11 executed:

- 12 (1) Pursuant to chapter 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
13 (2) After the office of elections establishes an election
14 by mail process for all registered voters of the
15 State;

16 shall reflect a reduction in the number of paid holidays to
17 which a public employee who is subject to the collective
18 bargaining agreement may be entitled in a calendar year in which
19 a general election occurs, as established under this Act;
20 provided that the loss of the general election holiday shall not
21 be considered a negotiable item for collective bargaining
22 purposes.




