
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2014-2015 for the following purposes:

6 (1) To alleviate the impact of previous
7 reductions in general fund appropriations to
8 the state foundation on culture and the
9 arts.

10 Total funding \$56,000

11 (2) To include seventeen title I schools in the
12 Artists in the Schools Program.

13 Total funding \$100,000

14 (3) To continue educational efforts in cultural
15 preservation through a partnership with the
16 Edith Kanakaole Foundation, University of
17 Hawaii Biographical Research Center, PBS

4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
