# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 11-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "~~[+]~~§11-7.5~~[+]~~ **Duties of the elections commission.** The  
4 duties of the elections commission are to:

5           (1) Hold public hearings;

6           (2) Investigate and hold hearings for receiving evidence  
7 of any violations and complaints;

8           (3) Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91;

9           (4) Employ, without regard to chapter 76, a full-time  
10 chief election officer, pursuant to section 11-1.6;

11           [and]

12           (5) Conduct a performance evaluation of the chief election  
13 officer every six months; and

14           ~~[+5+]~~ (6) Advise the chief election officer on matters  
15 relating to elections."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
