
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§286- Veterans donation check-off authorized. When
5 submitting an application for or renewal of a certificate of
6 registration, the applicant may designate \$1 or \$5 to be
7 deposited into the veterans services special fund established by
8 section 363- . The director shall revise the application form
9 to allow the designation of contributions to the special fund on
10 the face of the application form. A designation, once made, may
11 not be revoked."

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 363, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
14 and to read as follows:

15 "§363- Veterans services special fund; established.

16 (a) There is established in the state treasury the veterans
17 services special fund, into which shall be deposited:

- 1 (1) All moneys designated to be paid to this fund pursuant
- 2 to section 286- ;
- 3 (2) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund;
- 4 and
- 5 (3) Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies and
- 6 private persons.

7 All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in the fund
 8 shall become part of the fund.


9 (b) The fund shall be administered by the director.

10 (c) The director may expend moneys from the fund pursuant
 11 to the activities enumerated in section 363-3."

12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
