
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the construction of
2 a shared-use (bicycle and pedestrian) pathway along Kahekili
3 highway between East Hui Iwa street and Waihee road would
4 improve the quality of life of Kahaluu residents by helping to
5 promote healthy lifestyles and providing safe, environmentally
6 friendly, non-motor vehicle travel options for residents to
7 commute to nearby parks, schools, and convenience stores.

8 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
9 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
10 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
11 Hawaii for fiscal years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015:

12 To be expended by the department of transportation:

13 Kahekili highway, Oahu

14 Plans, design, and construction of a shared-use
15 pathway along the mauka side of Kahekili highway
16 stretching between East Hui Iwa street and Waihee road
17 that allows for two-directional bicycle and pedestrian
18 traffic.

5 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the capital
6 improvement project set forth in section 2 shall be expended by
7 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
