**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 27G-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "~~+~~§27G-3~~+~~ Access Hawaii committee; establishment;  
4 membership; chairperson. (a) There is established within the  
5 department of accounting and general services, the access Hawaii  
6 committee.

7           (b) The committee shall consist of not more than fifteen  
8 voting ex officio members, or their designated representatives,  
9 as follows:

- 10           (1) The comptroller;
- 11           (2) The administrator of the information and communication  
12 services division of the department of accounting and  
13 general services;
- 14           (3) The administrator of the state procurement office;
- 15           (4) The director of the office of information practices;

1 (5) The directors of not more than three government  
2 agencies using or planning to use the services of the  
3 portal manager;

4 (6) The administrative director of the courts;

5 (7) A representative of the Hawaii state senate appointed  
6 by the president of the senate;

7 (8) A representative of the Hawaii state house of  
8 representatives appointed by the speaker of the house  
9 of representatives; ~~and~~

10 (9) The chief information officers of the four  
11 counties~~[-]~~; and

12 (10) The chief information officer.

13 (c) The ~~comptroller~~ chief information officer or the  
14 chief information officer's designee shall serve as the  
15 chairperson of the committee."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Accounting and General Services

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this bill is to designate the Chief Information Officer (CIO) or the CIO's designee to serve on and chair the Access Hawaii Committee.

MEANS: Amend section 27G-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: The Access Hawaii Committee was established to oversee the State of Hawaii's internet portal activities. Now that the State has a full-time CIO to provide the overall direction and vision for information technology, naming the CIO as chair of the Access Hawaii Committee aligns the Committee's responsibilities with the State's strategic vision.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Improved coordination of the implementation, administration, and operation of the Access Hawaii Committee.
