
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING ANNUAL REGISTRATION AND SAFETY INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR MOPEDS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

1 WHEREAS, the rising price of gasoline has contributed to
2 the increasing number of persons riding mopeds as mopeds are a
3 less costly alternative to driving an automobile; and
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5 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu reports that in
6 every year since 2006, the number of registered mopeds in the
7 State of Hawaii has increased, and there are now over 30,000
8 registered mopeds; and
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10 WHEREAS, moped users include youths ages 15 years and
11 older, as well as out-of-state tourists who rent mopeds for
12 leisure without the assurance that the moped has been deemed to
13 be in a safe operating condition; and
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15 WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu's report of
16 approximately 354 moped-related accidents in 2012, with an
17 average of five fatalities per year since 2003, has resulted in
18 growing concern for the safety of all moped users in Hawaii; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation is required to
21 establish criteria and procedures for the annual safety
22 inspection of every moped under section 291C-202(c), Hawaii
23 Revised Statutes, but mandatory safety inspections have been
24 implemented only in the Counties of Maui and Hawaii; and
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26 WHEREAS, duties applicable to drivers of motor vehicles are
27 extended to persons driving mopeds under section 291C-193,
28 Hawaii Revised Statutes; now, therefore,



1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 2 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 3 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that annual registration
 4 and safety inspection requirements be established for mopeds
 5 throughout the State; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Customer
 8 Services of the City and County of Honolulu and Director of
 9 Transportation of the County of Kauai are requested to establish
 10 annual registration and safety inspection requirements for all
 11 mopeds as defined under section 291C-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes;

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Transportation
 15 is requested to establish criteria and procedures for annual
 16 safety inspections of mopeds, as required under section 291C-
 17 202, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
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19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 20 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
 21 Transportation, Director of Customer Services of the City and
 22 County of Honolulu, and the Director of Finance of the County of
 23 Kauai.
