
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CHIEF ELECTION OFFICER TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL
ELECTION POLLING PLACES IN STATE HOUSE DISTRICT 4.

1 WHEREAS, State House District 4, composed of the vast Puna
2 district in the County of Hawaii has one of the fastest-growing
3 residential populations in the State and requires voters living
4 on the outskirts of the district to travel long distances to
5 election polling places; and

7 WHEREAS, in the 2012 primary and general elections, there
8 were only three polling places serving State House District 4,
9 even though other voting districts of the County of Hawaii with
10 comparable numbers of registered voters were provided with more
11 polling places; and

13 WHEREAS, the establishment of additional polling places
14 within State House District 4 would provide much-needed relief
15 for district voters and alleviate the workload at present
16 polling places; and

18 WHEREAS, the Chief Election Officer has the authority to
19 establish new precincts and polling places within a
20 representative district under section 11-92.1, Hawaii Revised
21 Statutes; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
24 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
25 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that the Chief Election
26 Officer is requested to establish additional election polling
27 places in State House District 4 in time for the 2014 primary
28 election; and

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
31 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the Chief
