
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP AND EXAMINE WAYS TO STREAMLINE THE PROCESS FOR NAMING PUBLIC LANDS AND FACILITIES.

1 WHEREAS, the process of naming public lands and facilities
2 varies among state agencies; and

4 WHEREAS, the Legislature sometimes names public facilities;
5 and

7 WHEREAS, there is a need for clarity about the process for
8 naming public lands and facilities; and

10 WHEREAS, the Legislature wants to consider the feasibility
11 of streamlining and unifying the process for naming public lands
12 and facilities; now, therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
15 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
16 Session of 2014, that the Legislative Reference Bureau is
17 requested to convene a working group to investigate and report
18 on current state processes for naming public lands and
19 facilities; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group include:

22
23 (1) One member of the House of Representatives designated
24 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

25
26 (2) One member of the Senate designated by the President
27 of the Senate;

28
29 (3) One Native Hawaiian expert designated by the Office of
30 Hawaiian Affairs;

32 (4) Representatives from any state agencies that name
33 public lands and facilities; and





1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested
2 to prepare a report of its findings and recommendations,
3 including any proposed legislation, regarding the potential for
4 streamlining and unifying the process for naming public lands
5 and facilities; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested
8 to submit the report to the Legislature no later than twenty
9 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2015; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
12 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, President of the
13 Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Chief Executive
14 Officer of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, and Director of the
15 Legislative Reference Bureau.
