RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The liability protections afforded to
2	lifeguards in Act 170, Session Laws of Hawaii 2002, are
3	currently scheduled to sunset on June 30, 2014. Act 170
4	provides limited liability protection for county lifeguards and
5	counties providing lifeguard services on beaches or in the
6	ocean, except in the case of gross negligence or wanton acts or
7	omissions. This limited liability protection was made necessary
8	because some counties would not otherwise provide lifeguard
9	services at state beach parks, due to the fear of potential
10	liability. The legislature finds that Act 170 created a climate
11	in which lifeguard services can be provided by the counties
12	without fear of liability and, therefore, is a life-saving
13	measure that should be made permanent.
14	Act 82, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, established a system
15	of warning signs to increase public safety and protect the State
16	and the counties from unlimited liability arising out of
17	recreational activities on public lands. Because many public

lands contain conditions that may, under certain circumstances,

- 1 present potential risk or danger, Act 82 created a process
- 2 utilizing a risk assessment group and public input to determine
- 3 applicable areas where signs should be placed to notify people
- 4 of inherent dangers and provide the State and counties with
- 5 liability protections. This ongoing process allows for the
- 6 institutionalization and standardization of warning signs,
- 7 enhancing safety for residents and visitors alike, while also
- 8 serving as a shield for the State against costly lawsuits.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to make permanent liability
- 10 protections for the State and the counties, including county
- 11 lifeguard personnel, in public areas containing inherent
- 12 dangers.
