A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY CONSERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) All agencies shall evaluate and identify for
4 implementation energy efficiency retrofitting through
5 performance contracting. Agencies that perform energy
6 efficiency retrofitting may continue to receive budget
7 appropriations for energy expenditures at an amount that shall
8 not fall below the pre-retrofitting energy budget [~~but shall~~
9 ~~rise in proportion to any increase in the agency's overall~~
10 ~~budget for the duration of the performance contract or project~~
11 ~~payment term]~~."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
