A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYER UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST FUND CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide:

(1) Employer contribution amounts for plan years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 for Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund health benefit plan premiums for the employees of collective bargaining unit (10) and for state officers and employees excluded from collective bargaining and belonging to the same compensation plans as those officers and employees within collective bargaining unit (10) pursuant to section 89-11(q), Hawaii Revised Statutes, due to an impasse in negotiations on issues involving the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund; and (2) Employer plan contributions of a specific dollar amount equivalent to fifty per cent of the premium rates established by the board of trustees of the

Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund for
