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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENTS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the  
2 definition of programmatic agreement to accurately reflect what  
3 is required in the phased review of certain projects by the  
4 department of land and natural resources by specifying the  
5 federal law pursuant to which programmatic agreements must be  
6 developed.

7           SECTION 2. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
8 amended by amending the definition of "programmatic agreement"  
9 to read as follows:

10           "Programmatic agreement" means a document that sets forth  
11 the terms of a formal, legally binding agreement and establishes  
12 a process for consultation~~[,]~~ and review~~[, and compliance with~~  
13 ~~federal laws.]~~ pursuant to section 106 of the National Historic  
14 Preservation Act and its implementing regulations."

15           SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
