
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a reliable
2 irrigation system is the lifeline of Hawaii's agricultural
3 industry. To ensure that Hawaii's crops receive a steady and
4 dependable supply of water, sufficient funding is needed to
5 maintain and improve Hawaii's irrigation systems. Increasing
6 weather tendencies of extended drought events highlight the need
7 for timely repair and maintenance of these systems.

8 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding needed for
9 improvements to irrigation systems and associated agricultural
10 management facilities throughout the State.

11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
15 for the purpose of making capital improvements to irrigation
16 systems and associated agricultural management facilities in the
17 State.



1 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation in section 2
5 that are unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of
6 that date.

7 SECTION 4. The sum appropriated in section 2 of this Act
8 shall be expended by the department of agriculture for the
9 purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
