A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO
PROVIDE SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a substantial number
2 of inmates incarcerated at Halawa correctional facility have
3 significant substance abuse problems. However, the State's
4 largest correctional facility lacks the resources to provide
5 substance abuse treatment services to inmates who need them.

6 The purpose of this Act is to provide substance abuse
7 treatment services needed by inmates of the Halawa correctional
8 facility.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the
12 department of public safety to provide substance abuse treatment
13 services for inmates of the Halawa correctional facility.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 public safety for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
