A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TATTOOS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding two new sections to part XXX to be
3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

4 "§321- Restrictions on sale of tattoo supplies. (a) No
5 tattoo supplies shall be sold to:

6 (1) Any person under the age of eighteen years;

7 (2) Any person not licensed under this chapter as a tattoo
8 artist; or

9 (3) Any tattoo shop without a permit issued by the
10 department pursuant to section 321-373.5 and any rules
11 adopted pursuant to chapter 321.

12 (b) No person under the age of eighteen years old may be
13 tattooed or wear a tattoo.

14 (c) As used in this section, "tattoo supplies" means
15 tattoo machines ("guns"), needles, tubes (steel and disposable),
16 pigment (ink), clip cords, foot switches, and power supplies."

1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
