# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROVISIONAL LICENSES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) The examiner of drivers may waive the actual  
4 demonstration of ability to operate a motor vehicle for any  
5 person who [~~is~~]:

6 (1) Is at least eighteen years of age and who possesses a  
7 valid driver's license issued to the applicant in any  
8 other state of the United States, the District of  
9 Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American  
10 Samoa, Guam, a province of the Dominion of Canada, or  
11 the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands for  
12 the operation of vehicles in categories 1 through 3 of  
13 section 286-102[-]; or

14 (2) Has completed the same requirements of section  
15 286-102.6(f) in another state and possesses a  
16 comparable valid provisional license from that state."

17 SECTION 2. The department of transportation shall  
18 implement section 1 of this Act immediately upon approval of



1 this Act without the necessity of completing the adoption of  
2 administrative rules so that the administrative rules do not  
3 delay the implementation of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Provisional and Drivers Licenses; Requirement Waivers; Out-of-State

Authorizes the examiner of drivers to waive the actual demonstration of ability to operate a motor vehicle for persons who have a valid provisional license from another state and who have completed the same requirements of a provisional license in Hawaii. (SD1)
