# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**



1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds  
2 to create two additional full-time equivalent positions for the  
3 Lahainaluna high school boarding program to ensure the safety of  
4 students and enable them to remain on campus during the  
5 weekends.

6           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$           or so much  
8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the  
9 department of education to establish two full-time equivalent  
10 (2.00 FTE) positions, to ensure that students who participate in  
11 the Lahainaluna high school boarding program may safely remain  
12 on campus during the weekends.

13           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
14 education for the purposes of this Act.


15           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
