
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-2153, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established the University of Hawaii tuition
4 and fees special fund into which shall be deposited all revenue
5 collected by the university for regular, summer, and continuing
6 education credit tuition, tuition-related course and fee
7 charges, and any other charges to students, except as provided
8 by law. Moneys deposited into the fund shall be expended to
9 maintain or improve the university's programs and operations and
10 shall not be:

11 (1) Used as a justification for reducing any budget
12 request or allotment to the university unless the
13 university requests such a reduction;

14 (2) Transferred unless otherwise authorized by the
15 legislature; ~~and~~

16 (3) Restricted by the governor or the director of finance
17 without the prior approval of the legislature~~[-]~~; and



1 (4) Used by the university for any purposes related to
2 university projects, university systems, or networks
3 or any combination thereof, constructed or maintained
4 by the board under subpart D of part VI.

5 Any rule, policy, or action of any agency or individual in
6 contravention of this subsection shall be void as against public
7 policy."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
