A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 444-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted and to read
3 as follows:

4 "Incidental and supplemental work" means any work in a craft
5 or trade other than the craft or trade for which the licensee is
6 licensed that is directly related to and necessary for the
7 completion of a project undertaken by the licensee, subordinate to
8 the project, and for which the contract price, including labor,
9 materials, taxes, and related costs, to perform the work as a
10 percentage of the total contract price or the time involved to
11 perform the work as a percentage of the total time involved is not
12 more than the following:

17 \$100,000,001 - \$500,000,000	\$250,000.00	0.05%
