A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
3 "**§291-71 Designation of parking spaces for electric**
4 **vehicles; charging system[-]; penalty.** (a) Places of public
5 accommodation with at least one hundred parking spaces available
6 for use by the general public shall have at least one parking
7 space exclusively for electric vehicles and equipped with an
8 electric vehicle charging system located anywhere in the parking
9 structure or lot by July 1, 2012; provided that no parking space
10 designated for electric vehicles shall displace or reduce
11 accessible stalls required by the Americans with Disabilities
12 Act Accessibility Guidelines. Spaces shall be designated,
13 clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. Owners
14 of multiple parking facilities within the State may designate
15 and electrify fewer parking spaces than required in one or more
16 of their owned properties; provided that the scheduled
17 requirement is met for the total number of aggregate spaces on
18 all of their owned properties.



1 (b) Beginning January 1, 2015, an owner of a place of
2 public accommodation that fails to comply with this section
3 shall be fined:

4 (1) \$5,000 for noncompliance of fewer than thirty days;

5 (2) \$10,000 for noncompliance of thirty to fifty-nine
6 days;

7 (3) \$20,000 for noncompliance of sixty to eighty-nine
8 days; and

9 (4) \$50,000 for noncompliance for ninety days and for each
10 subsequent thirty day period, or portion of a thirty-
11 day period, thereafter.

12 Police officers shall issue a citation to the owner of a
13 place of public accommodation that fails to comply with this
14 section.

15 [~~b~~] (c) For the purposes of this section:

16 "Electric vehicle" means:

17 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section
18 286-2; or

19 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
20 propulsion energy from a battery with at least four
21 kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
22 recharged from an external source of electricity.



- 1 "Electric vehicle charging system" means a system that:
- 2 (1) Is capable of providing electricity from a non-vehicle
- 3 source to charge the batteries of one or more electric
- 4 vehicles;
- 5 (2) Meets recognized standards, including standard SAE
- 6 J1772 of SAE International; and
- 7 (3) Is designed and installed in compliance with article
- 8 625 of the National Electrical Code.

9 "Place of public accommodation" has the same meaning as

10 that provided in section 489-2."

11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed


