A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291-71 Designation of parking spaces for electric 4 vehicles; charging system[.]; penalty. (a) [Places of public 5 accommodation] Parking facilities with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by the general public shall 6 7 have at least one parking space exclusively for electric 8 vehicles and equipped with an electric vehicle charging system 9 located anywhere in the parking structure or lot by July 1, 10 2012; provided that no parking space designated for electric 11 vehicles shall displace or reduce accessible stalls required by 12 the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines. 13 Spaces shall be designated, clearly marked, and the exclusive 14 designation enforced. Owners of multiple parking facilities 15 within the State may designate and electrify fewer parking 16 spaces than required in one or more of their owned properties; provided that the scheduled requirement is met for the total 17 18 number of aggregate spaces on all of their owned properties.

19		kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
20		recharged from an external source of electricity.
21	"El∈	ectric vehicle charging system" means a system that:

1	(1)	Is capable of providing electricity from a non-vehicle
2		source to charge the batteries of one or more electric
3		vehicles;
4	(2)	Meets recognized standards, including standard SAE
5		J1772 of SAE International; and
6	(3)	Is designed and installed in compliance with article
7		625 of the National Electrical Code.
