A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPORT CULTURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$60,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the
4 administration and operational expenses of the aha moku advisory
5 committee, including staff salaries, equipment, and supplies,
6 travel expenses of members and the executive director,
7 community-based meeting coordination, and site visit costs.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$40,000 or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
13 community education on the administrative structure regarding
14 the aha moku system and on natural and cultural resource
15 management.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.


