A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILY COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 601-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, in all
4 family court cases, if the plaintiff or petitioner, as a result
5 of impoverishment, is unable to publish notice as required by
6 subsection (a), the plaintiff or petitioner shall file an
7 affidavit attesting to impoverishment and to the fact that,
8 after due and diligent search, the whereabouts of the individual
9 sought to be served are unknown. Upon such filings, the family
10 court shall order that service be made [~~by~~]:

11 (1) By forwarding a certified copy of the pleadings and
12 process to the individual at the last known address by
13 registered or certified mail, with a return receipt
14 requested and a directive to deliver to addressee
15 only[~~, by~~];

16 (2) By sending a certified copy of the pleadings and
17 process to the defendant's or respondent's closest
18 known relative, if any can be found[~~, and by~~];

Publication of Notices and Process; Posting Online; Family Court

Description:

Upon order of the family court and in addition to existing mailing and posting requirements, requires indigent plaintiffs to post a copy of the pleadings and process on a searchable internet website of general circulation, unless doing so is cost-prohibitive. Takes effect 1/1/2015.

RELATING TO UNCLAIMED PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 523A-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3 "(c) Except as provided in section 523A-12, moneys in the
4 unclaimed property trust fund shall be invested by the
5 administrator, and all investment earnings shall be deposited to
6 the credit of the general fund. Unclaimed cash from each
7 apparent owner shall be deposited to the credit of the general
8 fund if unclaimed in the following amounts and for the following
9 periods from the date of deposit into the unclaimed property
10 trust fund:

11 (1) Unclaimed cash of less than \$10, if unclaimed for a
12 period of two years;

13 (2) Unclaimed cash of at least \$10 but less than \$25, if
14 unclaimed for a period of three years;

15 (3) Unclaimed cash of at least \$25 but less than \$50, if
16 unclaimed for a period of five years;

17 (4) Unclaimed cash of at least \$50 but less than \$100, if
18 unclaimed for a period of ten years; and



1 (5) Unclaimed cash of \$100 or more, if unclaimed for a
2 period of twenty years."

3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.

Unclaimed Property; Cash Deposits

Description:

Provides for escheat of unclaimed cash in certain amounts for certain periods of time that were deposited into the unclaimed property trust fund.

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
