A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING PROJECTS ON OAHU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to extend the
special purpose revenue bond authorization under Act 113,
Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, to Honolulu Seawater Air
Conditioning, LLC, for the design and construction of a seawater
air conditioning district cooling system in downtown Honolulu to
June 28, 2019.

7 SECTION 2. Act 113, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is 8 amended by amending sections 4 and 5 to read as follows: 9 "SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is 10 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to 11 [June 30, 2014,] June 28, 2019, to issue special purpose revenue 12 bonds in whatever principal amounts the department shall 13 determine to be necessary to refund the special purpose revenue 14 bonds authorized in section 2 and to refund special purpose 15 revenue bonds authorized in this section, regardless of whether 16 the outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of 17

1 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue 2 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in 3 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall 4 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal 5 income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature 6 authorized by this section. 7 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose 8 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on [June 30, 2014.] 9 June 28, 2019." 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2014.
