A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91-13.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
3 "(c) All such issuing agencies shall take action to grant
4 or deny any application for a business or development-related
5 permit, license, or approval within the established maximum
6 period of time~~[, or the application shall be deemed approved,~~
7 ~~provided that a delay in granting or denying an application~~
8 ~~caused by the lack of quorum at a regular meeting of the issuing~~
9 ~~agency shall not result in approval under this subsection;~~
10 ~~provided further that any subsequent lack of quorum at a regular~~
11 ~~meeting of the issuing agency that delays the same matter shall~~
12 ~~not give cause for further extension, unless an extension is~~
13 ~~agreed to by all parties].~~

14 (d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any
15 agency that reviews and comments upon an application for a
16 business or development-related permit, license, or approval for
17 a housing project developed under section 201H-38 shall respond
18 within forty-five days of receipt of the application~~[, or the~~




1 ~~application shall be deemed acceptable as submitted to the~~
2 ~~agency]."~~

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
