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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that no amendments to the  
2 Hawaiian Homes Commission Act are required to accomplish the  
3 purposes of Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011.

4 SECTION 2. Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is  
5 amended by repealing section 3.

6 "~~SECTION 3. The Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920,~~  
7 ~~shall be amended, subject to approval by the United States~~  
8 ~~Congress, if necessary, to accomplish the purposes set forth in~~

## JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Hawaiian Home Lands

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT, 1920, AS AMENDED.

PURPOSE: Repeals the directive in Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, to amend the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended (HHCA).

MEANS: Repeal section 3 of Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011.

JUSTIFICATION: Section 3 of Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, required the amendment of the HHCA to accomplish the purposes of Act 195. However, no amendments to the HHCA are required to accomplish the purposes of the Native Hawaiian Roll Commission, thus section 3 is not necessary.

Impact on the public: This proposal avoids unnecessary amendments being made to the HHCA.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Same as above.
