A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE MED-QUEST DIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 A critical fiscal emergency exists. A funding shortfall in
- 5 the current fiscal year 2013-2014 in general support for health
- 6 care payments (HMS 902) is projected because the Hawaii health
- 7 connector has not yet reimbursed the department of human
- 8 services for all of the services and moneys provided to the
- 9 connector by the department.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$4,854,037 in
- 11 general funds for an emergency appropriation for fiscal year
- 12 2013-2014 for general support for health care payments (HMS 902)
- 13 to address the funding shortfall in the medicaid program
- 14 resulting from the delay in reimbursement.
- 15 The department of human services provided services and
- 16 funding to or for the sole benefit of the Hawaii health
- 17 connector to develop components of the health insurance exchange

- 1 required by the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care
- 2 Act. In addition, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid
- 3 Services requires that 5.25 per cent of department design,
- 4 development, and implementation costs as well as maintenance and
- 5 operations costs for the new Medicaid Kauhale On-Line
- 6 Eligibility Assistance system, or KOLEA, be cost-allocated to
- 7 the connector.
- 8 The services provided and the required 5.25 per cent cost
- 9 allocation for KOLEA were paid for with general funds encumbered
- 10 from HMS 902 with the understanding that the connector would
- 11 reimburse the department through the connector's own federal
- 12 funds. While encumbered, the department is unable to use these
- 13 funds for other purposes.
- 14 As of November 1, 2013, the costs allocated to the
- 15 connector that were owed or expected to be owed to the
- 16 department of human services for state fiscal year 2013-2014
- 17 totaled \$6,020,727 as follows:
- 18 (1) Allocated costs incurred for work performed on KOLEA
- design, development, and implementation, in the amount
- **20** of \$4,329,956;
- 21 (2) Allocated costs incurred for work performed on KOLEA
- maintenance and operations in the amount of \$306,161;

1	(3)	Costs incurred for work performed that would have
2		allowed connector system functionality so individuals
3		could browse for and select qualified health plans for
4		both medicaid and the connector at the same time, in
5		the amount of \$450,800;
6	(4)	Costs incurred for work performed on the transition
7		necessary to revise the connector system to separate
8		the browsing and selection functions for medicaid and
9		the connector when the design was changed, in the
10		amount of \$418,950;
11	(5)	Costs incurred for work performed to allow the
12		connector to interface with the state data services
13		hub in the amount of \$296,940;
14	(6)	Costs incurred for work performed to revise the file
15		format and interface control document as previously
16		agreed upon so that the connector could process
17		electronically transferred files, in the amount of
18		\$52,920; and
19	(7)	Costs expected to be incurred for work to be performed
20		as agreed by the connector to allow the connector to
21		perform remote identity proofing, in the amount of

\$165,000.

21	department is able to fund its core operations and continue to			
22	serve its be	serve its beneficiaries.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,854,037 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 to be used
- 4 for general support for health care payments (HMS 902).
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
