BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 235-20.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The moneys in the fund shall be used for the 4 following purposes: 5 Issuing comfort letters, letter rulings, written (1)6 opinions, and other guidance to taxpayers; 7 (2) Issuing certificates under sections 235-110.9 and 235-8 110.91; [and] 9 (3) Administering the operations of the special 10 enforcement section[-]; and 11 (4)Developing, implementing, and providing taxpayer 12 education programs, including tax publications." 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
