A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§103- Civil rights compliance. (a) Notwithstanding
5 chapter 103D or 103F to the contrary, all contractors and
6 prospective contractors, including those who are exempt from
7 chapter 103D or 103F, shall comply with the following state and
8 federal laws:

- 9 (1) Part I of chapter 378, chapter 489, and chapter 515 of
10 the Hawaii Revised Statutes;
11 (2) Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended
12 (Title 42 United States Code section 2000e et seq.);
13 (3) Equal Pay Act of 1963 (Title 29 United States Code
14 section 206(d));
15 (4) Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967, as
16 amended (Title 29 United States Code section 621 et
17 seq.);

- 3 (6) Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008

10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
