A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a
2 minimum number of days in the school year.

3 More specifically, this Act:

4 (1) Requires the school year to be lengthened from one
5 hundred eighty days to one hundred ninety days
6 commencing with the 2015-2016 school year. The
7 legislature intends that the one hundred eighty-day
8 requirement continue to apply for the 2014-2015 school
9 year; and

10 (2) Repeals the minimum instructional hour requirements on
11 July 1, 2014. By this repeal, the legislature intends
12 that the requirements no longer apply from the school
13 year 2014-15.

14 SECTION 2. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 "~~§302A-251 School year; [instructional time.]~~ minimum
17 number of school days. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to
18 the contrary, [~~beginning with~~] for the [2011-2013] 2011-2012 to

11 to any individual school ~~[subject to the student instructional~~

14 board shall adopt policies and procedures to grant a waiver
15 under this subsection.

16 ~~(f)~~ For purposes of this section, "student instructional
17 hours" ~~means student learning time during which students are~~
18 ~~engaged in learning activities including regularly scheduled~~
19 ~~instruction and learning assessments within the curriculum, and~~
20 ~~does not include lunch, recess, or passing time.~~

21 ~~(g)~~ (d) The department of education, with the board of
22 education and office of the governor, and in consultation with



1 representatives of the affected collective bargaining units,
2 shall submit to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
3 to the convening of the regular sessions of 2013, 2014, 2015,
4 2016, 2017, and 2018, a report on its progress and efforts to
5 meet the requirements of [~~subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d).~~]
6 this section."

7 SECTION 3. Act 162, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, as
8 amended by Act 52, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is amended by
9 repealing section 4.

10 [~~"SECTION 4. The department of education shall, with the
11 board of education and office of the governor and in
12 consultation with representatives of the affected collective
13 bargaining units, submit to the legislature, no later than
14 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
15 2015, a plan to implement beginning with the 2018-19 school
16 year, for elementary and secondary school grades at all public
17 schools, excluding charter schools and multi-track public
18 schools, a school year of one hundred ninety days, excluding
19 professional development days and other non-instructional days
20 negotiated pursuant to chapter 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes, that
21 shall include one thousand one hundred forty student
22 instructional hours.~~]
