A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 206E-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The authority shall adopt community and public notice
4 procedures pursuant to chapter 91 that shall include at a
5 minimum:

6 (1) A means to effectively engage the community in which
7 the authority is planning a development project to
8 ensure that community concerns are received and
9 considered by the authority; provided that:

10 (A) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
11 authority shall assign at least three members,
12 but less than the number of members that would
13 constitute a quorum, to attend every scheduled
14 community engagement session, but shall comply
15 with the reporting and other meeting requirements
16 of section 92-2.5; and

17 (B) A violation of this paragraph shall not
18 constitute a violation of chapter 92;



1 (2) The posting of the authority's proposed plans for
2 development of community development districts, public
3 hearing notices, and minutes of its proceedings on the
4 authority's website; and

5 (3) Any other information that the public may find useful
6 so that it may meaningfully participate in the
7 authority's decision-making processes."

8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
