A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 for the executive office on early learning to enter into
- 3 contracts with third party providers for family-child
- 4 interaction learning programs as part of a mixed-delivery early
- 5 learning system to ensure school readiness for Hawaii's children
- 6 prior to entering kindergarten.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the
- 10 executive office on early learning to enter into contracts with
- 11 third party providers for family-child interaction learning
- 12 programs.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 14 office on early learning for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
