A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$24,674,500 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
5 for capital improvement projects for the twenty-fourth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

 18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
